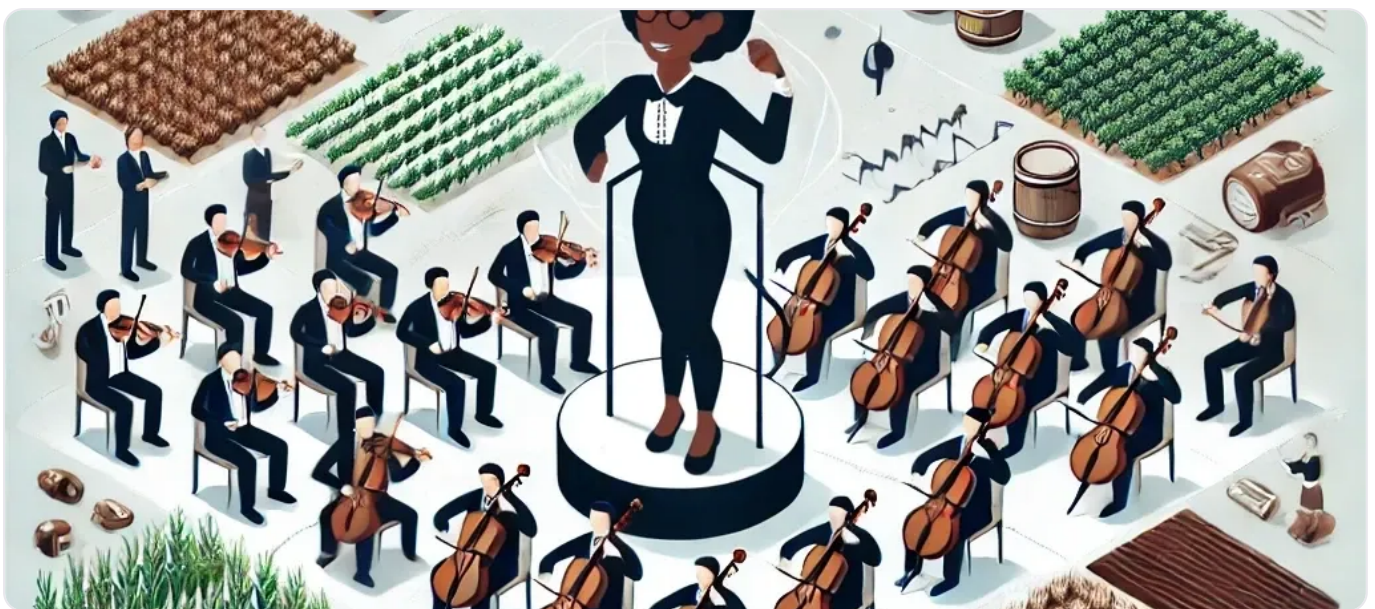

Meet the Maestros: Mutu, Managing Director and Group CFO of Olam International

Introduction and Summary:

In this episode of Sensei Labs' "Meet the Maestro" series, Jay Goldman interviews Mutu, Managing Director and Group CFO of Olam International. The conversation focuses on the complexities of Olam's transformation, including its ongoing reorganization into three distinct business groups and the upcoming IPO. Mutu shares insights into how Olam is navigating these challenges, with a strong emphasis on aligning people, processes, and technology to drive better outcomes and manage complexity across their global operations.

Olam International, a major global agricultural supply chain and processing company, operates across 60 countries and manages over 200 manufacturing facilities, handling 47 agricultural commodities. Mutu explains that the reorganization, which involves splitting the company into Olam Food Ingredients (OFI), Olam Global Agri (OGA), and Olam International Limited, is intended to unlock long-term value for shareholders. The planned IPO of OFI, which is expected to be the largest in the agricultural industry since 2014, requires that Olam maintain high standards of governance, data security, and operational efficiency.

Mutu outlines the key challenges Olam faces in orchestrating this transformation while continuing to manage day-to-day business operations. With over 250 legal entities across 60 countries, the task of ensuring that business units remain focused on delivering results, while navigating the structural carve-out, is formidable. Olam has taken significant steps to ensure minimal distractions for its management teams, leveraging technology for communication and operational oversight. This has been particularly important during the COVID-19 pandemic, which forced the company to adapt to remote work and limit travel.

The pandemic impacted some of Olam's non-food commodities, such as cotton and wood products, but the company's focus on food-related commodities helped it weather the crisis. The demand for food commodities, driven by concerns around food security, provided a tailwind for Olam's performance, enabling strong financial results in 2020 and 2021, despite global disruptions.

Technology has played a critical role in Olam's transformation efforts. Mutu highlights the use of drones and video tools like FaceTime and WhatsApp for monitoring inventory and managing supply chains remotely. Olam has also used Sensei Labs' Conductor platform (rebranded internally as "Pulse") to drive cost and capital transformation initiatives. The platform has helped Olam transition away from manual, Excel-based processes to a more integrated, user-friendly system that tracks cost-saving initiatives and capital efficiency across the organization. The collaborative nature of the platform has fostered real-time data visibility, enabling better decision-making and competitive benchmarking across Olam's global teams.

In closing, Mutu offers valuable advice for companies embarking on large-scale transformations. He stresses the importance of moving from planning to execution, maintaining flexibility to adapt to challenges, and leveraging technology to enhance collaboration and efficiency. He also emphasizes the

need for constant communication and openness to feedback, both internally and externally, to ensure the success of transformation initiatives.

Mutu's insights provide practical guidance for organizations facing complex transformations, offering lessons on how to balance strategic restructuring with operational excellence.

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
